

Dispatcher's Harness Airsafe 1100

The Airsafe 1100 harness was developed for dispatchers and crew on C-130 aircrafts in cooperation with the Swedish Air Force.

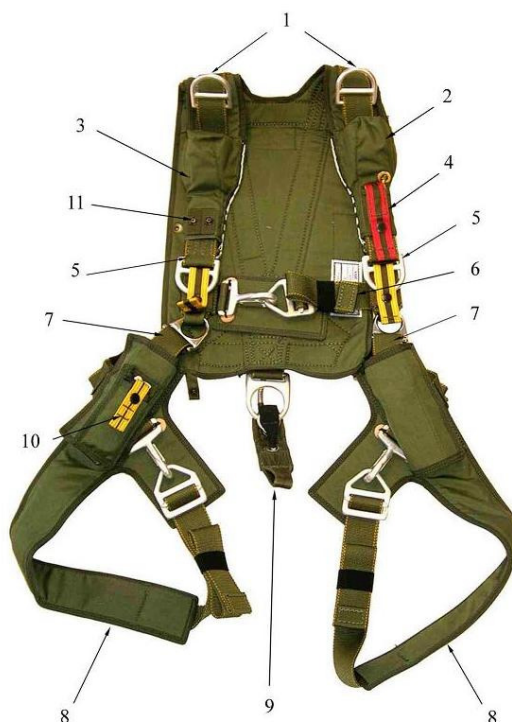
The Airsafe 1100 is an integrated parachute harness. In Sweden Airsafe 1100 is approved to use with the Butler Quick Attachable Chest with HX-500 canopy. The rescue parachute is attached to the D-rings in the front of the harness. The D-rings are connected to two Capewell canopy releases.

The harness can be used in combination with a CSAR vest. The vest is worn under the harness. It also has a pocket for emergency oxygen. Due to the differences between different oxygen systems, the pocket can be custom made.

The harness is attached to a fixed point in the aircraft using an elastic attachment sling. There is a three-ring release in the back for quick release. There are also attachment slings for tactical flight which can be attached either to the shoulder D-rings or the chest strap.

Custom design

The Airsafe 1100 harness can be modified to meet the specific requirements of different customers. During 2008/2009 a version for the Norwegian Air Force is being developed for use in the C-130 J-model.

- (4) Safe Handle for Release Wire
- (5) Riser D-rings
- (6) Chest Strap
- (7) Leg Straps
- (8) Covered Leg Straps
- (9) Three-Ring Release
- (10) Knife
- (11) Snap Button for Oxygen Pocket
