

Life jacket Airsafe A-290

Suitable for use in aircrafts and helicopters, to be worn during flight by pilots and passangers.

Airsafe life jacket A-290 is based on a two chamber life jacket (two separate chambers) of the EAM KSE-35L8 alternative EAM XF-35, a life jacket with TSO approval. The jacket is fitted with two carbon dioxide cartridges wich can be released in one simple operation, water activated illumination and two separate inflation valves. The jacket is folded into its protective valise using a apacially tested method in order to ensure safe and complete expansion of the chambers.

The horseshoe shaped jacket is sewn into those protective Cordura valise with flame proof filling wich is also shaped across the shoulders so that it does not press on the back of the head/neck or get in the way of any flight helmet. This design makes it possible to put on and remove the jacket without having to pull it over the head. The A-290 model is fitted with a 40 mm waist strap with a quick release buckle. As the jacket inflates, the zipper in the valise opens quickly, efficiently and automatically.

Optional Equipment

Optional equipment includes one or two removable pockets containing Skyblazer signal flares or a strobe light for emergency use.

The A-290 is used by, among others, the Swedish Coastguard air division, the Police air division, FMV – The Swedish Defence Material Administration, Patria Ostermans and Saab Nyge Aero.

The A-290 can also be modified into A-290 HEED emergency air supply. See A-290 HEED paper for more information
